Did you know that Paly has a glass blowing studio? Yes, the Paly Glass studio is a hidden treasure. It's part of the Paly sculpture curriculum. Paly sculpture students have access to a full ceramic and sculpture studio as well as glass blowing and bead-making. There are only a handful of public high schools that have this comprehensive sculpture curriculum. We need your help to continue this unique Paly program.

Over 90 students a year in Sculpture and Advanced Sculpture classes have this incredible opportunity to engage in hands on projects that encourage creativity, visualization, and teamwork. They can also develop the technical skills and processes of an artist and craftsman.

The studio has to self-fund its operating budget of ~\$50,000 per year. This is how:
