### **Stay connected: PalyLink**

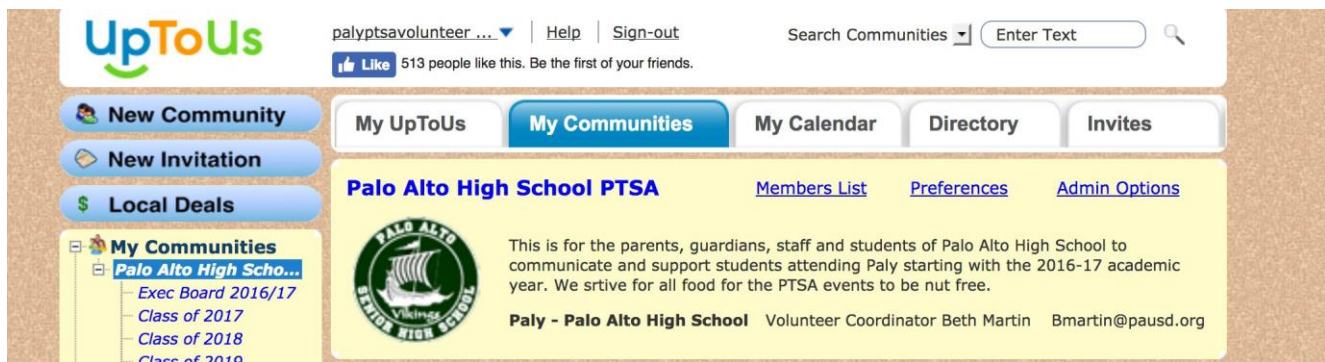

## Paly On-line Directory : UpToUs

The online directory is available to all families. You may choose which information is displayed in the directory. To access it, you can sign in as a guest (just enter your email), or preferably, create an uptous account. 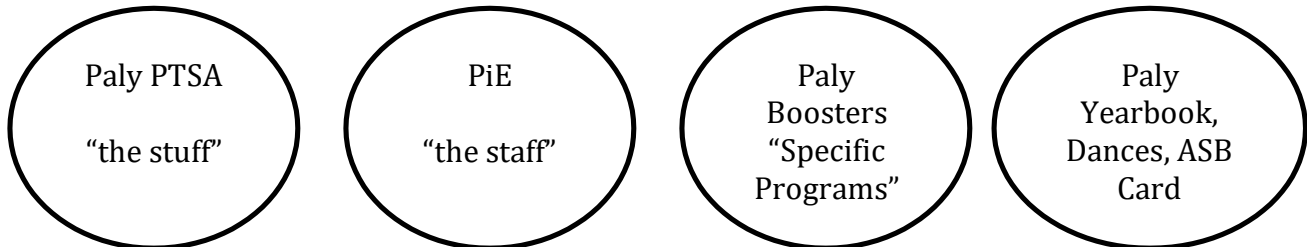
